"21st Century Classroom" opened recently at the Southern College of Seventh-day Adventists in Collegedale, Tennessee. It was uniquely designed to support the professional vision of the college's Department of Education and Psychology as they seek to prepare teachers for the classroom environment of the future.

In the 21st century, teachers will need to understand and use an array of technology for enhancing learning. Instead of being a purveyor of knowledge, the teacher will be the manager of an extensive information system tailored to the educational needs of the student.

Video Tutoring and Other Classroom Components

The high-tech classroom in Summerour Hall includes an eight-foot-byseven-foot video-wall—the first in the world installed in a classroom. It plays a pivotal role in training education students in the techniques of video conferencing in an educational environment, otherwise known as video tutoring.

Other components include 24 "view port" stations with multimedia computers, an electronic chalkboard that transmits information directly to student computers, and a network-transparent computer management system permitting the teacher to view and control each computer as needed, and to send video or audio to an individual screen or the entire class. All of the 21st Century Classroom components, including the lighting, are controlled electronically from a six-inch-by-six-inch touch
